The State of the Union Housing Address

Realtor.com released its own report noting a strong economy and unprecedented housing shortage are "pressuring potential home buyers striving to attain the American Dream.

According to Joe Kirchner, senior economist for Realtor.com, "The macro-factors that have defined real estate in recent years — strong demand and weak supply — continue to set the tone for the industry. The new tax law that caps the mortgage interest deduction and the deductibility of state and local taxes can be expected to impact the upper-end market in 2018 — precisely how and the extent of which remain to be seen."

Cybersecurity threats to watch for in 2018

- Passwords failing. Not the time to "keep it simple." Develop strong passwords.
- Compliance keeps your security up-to-date but 10 years too late. Hackers think ahead
- Too many people have access.
- Breach fatigue. Do not become complacent.

Yikes. Bottom line is to take cybersecurity very seriously.

Avoid wire fraud

Things to beware of. Recently hackers have targeted real estate transactions. A serious concern: Hackers send fake emails with bogus wiring instructions to homebuyers on the eve of closing.

Buyers are advised:

- \Rightarrow Be aware how wire instructions are sent. Accept instructions that are secure and encrypted.
- \Rightarrow Call to verify wire instructions with the title company or closing agent.
- ⇒ Be on the lookout for changes. Instructions rarely change so if you have an email requesting a last minute change, verify the validity.
